5:00 pm ~ **Pre-Show.** Late entries taken until DRAW #50 runs. Late entries posted after #125. *\$5 late fee applies if not pre-entered.*

8:15 am ~ **Opening Ceremonies**

9:00 am ~ **First go of OPEN** Number of riders advancing to Open Finals is based on number of entries.
